

Transportation Multimodal Planning Specialist Positions

Two positions are available which will be located at DMV Headquarters at 2300 West Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia. The incumbents of these positions work closely with the Secretary of Transportation and agencies of the Secretariat to enhance statewide multimodal planning processes through innovation and incorporation of the latest planning analysis methodology. Positions are responsible for coordinating and conducting multimodal planning analysis and plan development efforts; overseeing the development of the Statewide Multimodal Plan and coordinating other planning efforts related to the Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment. Incumbents will assist in statewide multimodal transportation planning initiatives leading to implementation. Responsible for managing consultant contracts; developing and monitoring scopes of work, schedules and deliverables; coordinating with other Multimodal planners; conducting and reviewing technical analysis associated with multimodal planning initiatives. Work closely with staff at the Departments of: DMV, Rail and Public Transportation, VDOT, Port Authority and Aviation to access pertinent data to assist with multimodal planning and to develop database(s) used to analyze data and produce technical reports.

Degree in Urban and Regional Planning, Transportation Policy, Public Administration or related experience. Demonstrated knowledge of transportation planning analysis techniques as it relates to at least one of the following: rail, ports, aviation, highway, public transportation, transportation demand management, and bike and pedestrian. Working knowledge of federal/state/local transportation planning regulations/policies/guidelines/procedures as it relates to the above list. Demonstrated experience in writing and presenting formal technical reports and with legislation, finance, budget and grants. Demonstrated knowledge of relational database theory. Knowledge of: GIS Tools and spatial analysis techniques; transportation safety; state and federal motor carrier and federal public transportation laws and regulations; and MPO and Regional Transportation Planning. Experience with Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS). Extensive project management experience. Proficient in use of computers and Microsoft applications. Considerable knowledge of research and evaluation techniques, quantitative and qualitative analysis as well as statistical analysis. Must be able to work independently and also in a team environment.

Masters degree in Urban and Regional Planning, Transportation Policy, Public Administration preferred, or American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP) certification. Successful candidates must consent to a fingerprint background check. Salary is commensurate with experience. Position will remain open until filled.
