STRATEGICALLY-LOCATED INLAND BARGE TERMINAL

- → Frequent, streamlined service. RMT's strategic inland location serves customers in Central and Western Virginia with a barge service between ocean and inland terminals. The three-barge, six-day-per-week service has a combined capacity of 500 FEUs.
- → Efficient inland turn times. The terminal's operational efficiency helps truckers maximize daily service schedules. RMT also provides ease of accessing and terminating empty containers at an inland versus ocean terminal.
- → Transload and cross-docking capabilities. Transload and cross-dock services are available for container cargo transfers via rail or truck. The terminal also has covered and outside storage available for customers utilizing transload services.
- → Reducing emissions. Customers are able to substantially reduce their CO2 emissions with the barge service versus all over-theroad inland movements.

INFRASTRUCTURE ENHANCEMENTS

- → Enhanced gate efficiency. The terminal upgraded its gate throughput to allow for faster processing of trucks. (Completed in 2024)
- → Extended drop-lot access. A new secured area was developed to provide truckers with the ability to drop off after hours for nextday processing. (Completed in 2024)
- → Expanded barge schedule, efficiency. Lighting improvements will be installed to extend the barge loading/unloading schedule for faster turn times. (Estimated Completion - Q1 2025)
